The Community Wellbeing Project is commissioned by Public Health and delivered by a third sector organisation Valley House in partnership with the Community Empowerment Network and Grapevine.

What is the Community Wellbeing Project?

The aim of the Community Wellbeing Project is to develop the Wellbeing and build up resilience of communities in Coventry.

There are 90 small grants of up to £500 each with the aim to enable communities to deliver activities to promote Wellbeing. Grassroots Community Groups are encouraged to apply.

The project aims to share and champion the 10 ways to wellbeing by working with local communities to:

- Promote the 10 ways to wellbeing for Coventry
- Support community groups or active residents to take action on the 10 ways to wellbeing
- Use the 10 ways to identify community assets (the good things that exist) and build on these to improve wellbeing across Coventry

How are we going to do this?

Community mapping

The Community Worker will create a network of contacts in each area by completing community mapping exercise to find out what people do/go to in their local community.

Support

The Community Wellbeing Worker is available to offer support to groups and individuals to explore how they can improve their health and wellbeing by using the 10 Ways to Feeling Good and Doing Well in Coventry.

Roadshows

2x Road shows will be delivered in each priority neighbourhood (please see attached schedule) by the Community Worker and Project leader to:

- Promote the '10 Ways to Feeling Good and Doing Well in Coventry' message
- Gather further information for Community Mapping
- To promote the Small Grants and share information regarding the application process
- Gather baseline information for evaluation and monitoring purposes
